The Committee had a presentation from American Ramp Company. Damon Schuber was present at the meeting and gave the Committee a presentation on there Solo equipment. Jerry also informed the Committee that the District received \$5,000 from the Tony Hawk Foundation.

**3. Dewey Street Trial**

**4. Swimming Pool**
