1. Skateboard Park

The Committee discussed the proposal from Bill Rench for additional work at the skate park. Jerry was asked to get another quote.

2. Breehne Park

The Committee discussed the offer from Carl Breehne to donate a carport structure to be used as a pavilion at Breehne park. Jerry was asked to discuss the details of the addition with Carl. The Park District would be responsible for putting concrete under the structure.

3. Demoulins Museum

The Committee reviewed a request from John Goldsmith for funding for his new museum. The Committee discussed the current lease agreement it has with the Historical Society. Jerry stated that he had been informed by the Society that the museum building needed some repairs and there may be a request for additional funding for the 2010 contract. Jerry stated that he was scheduled to meet with the Society on Monday November 2.

Jerry informed the Committee that work on the levy was almost complete. The Committee discussed staying under the 105%.

5. Jaycee Parking Lot

The committee discussed the location of the Jaycee parking lot. The consensus of the Committee was to put it on the west side near the bathroom.

Jerry was asked to look at the costs for concession and bathroom only.
